

GUR – Abnormal ground conditions.

Preferred lie 15th fairway only.

Irrigation trenches and works on right hand side of 5th hole, left hand side of 9th and left-hand side of 10th fairways.

Bare areas and on the putting greens. Proceed under Rule 16-1d. Putting green edge is defined by the edging groove.

Newly turfed areas on the 1st, 7th, 8th, 9th, 11th, 13th, 14th, 16th, 18th putting greens. Proceed under Rule 16-1d. Putting green edge is defined by the edging groove.

No play Zone 8th hole.

The area within the red penalty area left of the 8th fairway defined by the green stakes with yellow fencing, is a no play zone that is treated as a penalty area and relief must be taken from interference by the no play zone under Rule 17.1e

Artificial spare “Championship” holes on putting greens.

Relief from interference by an immovable obstruction may be taken under [Rule 16.1](#).

The player has an extra option to take relief when such immovable obstructions are on or close to the putting green and on the line of play:

Ball in General Area: The player may take relief under [Rule 16.1b](#) if an immovable obstruction is:

- On the line of play, and is:
 - On or within two club-lengths of the putting green, and
 - Within two club-lengths of the ball.

But complete relief must be taken, which includes both physical and line of play interference.

Exception - No Relief If Line of Play Clearly Unreasonable. There is no relief under this Local Rule if the player chooses a line of play that is clearly unreasonable.

Orange tee markers: Players playing from these tee markers may tee off two club lengths either side of the markers.

A BREACH OF THE LOCAL RULES INCURS THE GENERAL PENALTY (TWO STROKES)
